I am aware that many of you are very concerned about what next school year will be like due to Covid-19's prevalence and the fact that there is no vaccine yet developed to assist us. As of this date, we are planning to reopen school in August with students in classrooms. However, now that the economy is reopening, we are not very sure what guidelines will be forthcoming from our Governor. As a result, we are also looking at some alternatives depending on what the Pandemic is like at that time. I am certain that we will all still be required to wear mask. In addition we are in the process of ordering face shields that each students and faculty member will wear as added protection.


We have completely cleaned and sanitized all classrooms and will do so again in August. Please bear in mind that any virus that may have been in any classroom would not be active at this time. We will be making changes in our plumbing to assist with the overall health of our students. We will be adding more hand-washing stations on each floor in the lower school section. There will also be more hand-washing machines around the campus. Both kindergarten classrooms will have their own sinks for washing hands. Faucets in sinks will be changed to motion sensor ones. We will have powerful hand driers in the bathrooms and on the walls outside.

I have not yet been able to meet with the Director of the School Lunch program to ascertain how she plans to structure the breakfast and lunch program in the schools. WE probably would have to package each student's lunch and breakfast and have them eat in the classrooms. Please be reminded that all schools that participate in the school lunch program MUST also serve breakfast to continue to get lunch. We would send out a survey to parents to ask some pertinent questions and also find out how many students will be participating in the breakfast portion so that we don't over or under prepare.

We have ordered new furniture for the kindergarten classrooms so that they will no longer sit at what is ideal and better for them: round tables. Students in both classes will sit at individual desks. We have ordered the temperature checking thermometers to be used each morning when students arrive. Parents will no longer be allowed to come on campus and "hang around" until the school day starts.

Parents, we are all anxious at this time. Please note that a committee will be having ongoing meetings to plan and prepare for the upcoming school year. As plans unfold, you will be updated in a timely manner. Please note that your child's safety is of paramount importance to us and we will do all in our power to ensure a safe campus.
