Welcome to the start of the 2022-2023 school year. We are very excited as we continue to give our students a moral, ethical and academic education. School opens on Monday, August 22, 2022 for our students. We pride ourselves in giving a quality education while we embrace our diversity in a nurturing and caring manner.

Orientation for our students is as follows:

Grades JrK to 2..... August 18, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. in the Cathedral  
Grades 3 to 5.....August 18, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Cathedral  
Grades 6 to 8 .....August 19, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. in the Cathedral  
Grades 9 to 12 .....August 19, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Cathedral.

You will have the opportunity to meet your child's teachers then. Students must be dressed in full uniform for Orientation. Please take some time to read the Student Handbook on the school's website, especially with respect to uniform. Allow me to give just a few reminders:

- Girls' socks must be green or white and must be quite visible **above** the ankle. Peds and anklets are not acceptable.
- Patches must be properly sewn on the upper left side of the blouse or shirt; not pinned on.
- Students in Middle and High School must wear brown or black shoes except on Phys. Ed days.
- Elementary students may wear sneakers or shoes to school. Sneakers must be black and may contain small streaks of green or white.
- Polo shirts and blouses are not allowed.
- Unnatural hair colors are not allowed.

Gym uniforms and patches can be purchased from the office between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Please be reminded that the late fee for tuition will be reinstated in October. You have two months to catch up with tuition so that you will be on track by October. Please be reminded that there is a late fee of \$125.00 for tuition paid after the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month.

We have lost some staff members and have new replacements. We say best wishes to those we have lost and welcome to those who have joined us. Please be assured that your child will continue to be well educated and nurtured. I stand ready and willing to be of assistance to each and every one of you. Please do not hesitate to contact me with your concerns or suggestions.
